
Acts chapters 3 & 4

The healing of the lame man, and the events following it

- **3:1-10 -** The healing of the lame man
- **3:10-26 –** Peter's speech
 - explanation of the healing
 - Christ's death and resurrection, and the power He sent to perform miracles like this one
- **4:1-4** The apostles arrested for preaching about Jesus Christ's resurrection
- 4:5-22 The Sanhedrin and its decision
- **4:23-31** The apostles' release, and their report





A believer's expectation during the Acts period was that Christ would return "soon", and set up the earthly kingdom.

Note the following references, all written during the time covered by the book of Acts:

The end of all things is at hand. (1 Peter 4:7)

The coming of the Lord is at hand. (James 5:8)

It is the last hour ... you have heard that antichrist shall come, even now many antichrists have come, by which we know that it is the last hour.

(1 John 2: 18)

He who is coming, will come, and will not tarry. (Hebrews 10:37)

The day is at hand. (Romans 13:12)

The time is short. (1 Corinthians 7:29)

The "Near" Return of the Lord

Acts Period

Israel prominent in God's dealings

Today

Israel set aside nationality not relevant now

Future

Israel prominent in God's dealings again

29AD 60AD ??AD (future)

Acts period writings speak of near return:

"The coming of the Lord is near!"

Post-Acts period writings do not speak of near return:

Coming of the Lord presently not near".

Conditions similar to Acts period in force:


"The coming of the Lord is near!"

Many prophecies have yet to be fulfilled before Christ returns to the earth

The New Testament




Israel a Kingdom of Priests
