deception regarding the Messiah

affliction stumbling due to affliction and false prophets endurance is necessary

Abomination, tribulation, flight, deception (Matt 24:15-28):

Temple desecrated - 3 ½ years to go until the Lord's coming Jerusalem downtrodden

A time of tribulation - the command to flee

Deception will be prominent in those times

The Lord's Coming (Matt 24:29-31):

Celestial peculiarities
Israel shall mourn
Lord comes to the earth in the clouds
Trumpet sounds
Elect gathered from other places

1 Chron 29:10,11 - ... David said, Blessed be thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever. Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all.

Psalm 145:11-13 - [Thy works and thy saints] shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power; To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom. Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations.

Matthew 24:30 - they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
