






What happened between Christ's death ... and His resurrection?





AND IN JESUS CHRIST, HIS ONLY SON, OUR LORD, WHO WAS CONCEIVED BY THE HOLY SPIRIT, BORN OF THE VIRGIN MARY, SUFFERED UNDER PONTIUS PILATE, WAS CRUCIFIED, DIED AND WAS BURIED; HE DESCENDED INTO HELL; ON THE THIRD DAY HE ROSE AGAIN FROM THE DEAD; HE ASCENDED INTO HEAVEN, AND IS SEATED AT THE RIGHT HAND OF GOD THE FATHER ALMIGHTY;



There are several variations of this creed. Some do not include the phrase, "He descended into Hell".

"Descended into Hell"?

Often supported by:

1 Peter 4:6 – "the gospel was preached also to those who are dead"
1 Peter 3:19 – "[Christ] went and preached to the spirits in prison" cp. 2 Peter 2:4; Jude 6
Ephesians 4:9 – "He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth"

However, <u>none</u> of these verses teach that Christ "descended into hell after His death.

The Soul:

Dust + Breath of Life = A living being. (Genesis 2:7)

A person does not <u>have</u> a soul. A person <u>is</u> a soul - i.e., a living being.

✤ Death:

A person ceases to be conscious or alive in any form at the point of death.

- "The dead know nothing" (Ecclesiastes 9:5)
- "There is no work or device or knowledge or wisdom in the grave" (Ecclesiastes 9:10)
- "In death there is no remembrance of You; in the grave, who will give You thanks?" (Psalm 6:5)
- "Sheol (the grave) cannot thank You; death cannot praise You; Those who go down to the pit cannot hope for Your truth. The living, the living man, he shall praise You." (Isaiah 38:18,19)
- "The patriarch David ... is both dead and buried ... David did not ascend into the heavens"

(Acts 2:29,34)

Christ's Death, Burial, Resurrection

After His death on the cross, Christ lay in the tomb – dead, unconscious, motionless and without life in any form ... until His resurrection.



The N.T. chronologies are consistent


